1 Welcome



In advance, label an extra copy of Teaching Aid 3.



Instead of the student in the circle asking questions, he or she can call on a friend to share one fact that he or she knows.

Using Teaching Aid 3 tabernacle poster, divide students into groups of two and ask them to locate the people, places and things listed on page 79 of your Teacher Guide. Call out these places one at a time.

2 Bible Time



Hang a sheet in the classroom to show the separation between the Holy Place and Most Holy Place in the tabernacle.



While completing *In Class 11* activity “Drawing Near to God”, allow time for students to share their personal experiences.



Ask students to close their *In Class 11* paper. Read “Jesus Came for Us” and ask students to stand up when they hear an answer for “After Jesus Was Born”.

Tip: If you notice a student is not engaged in your teaching, simply saying his or her name as part of an example can draw him or her back into the lesson.



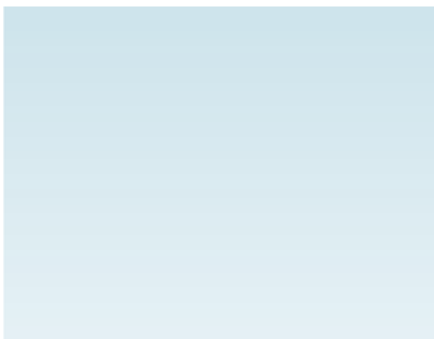
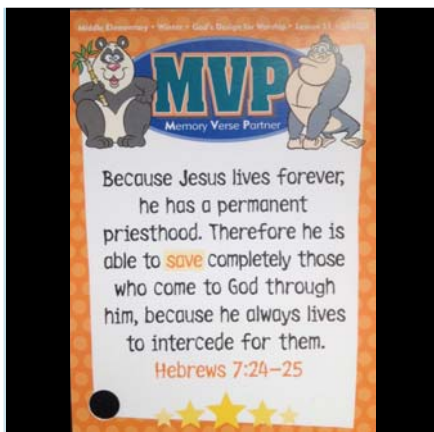
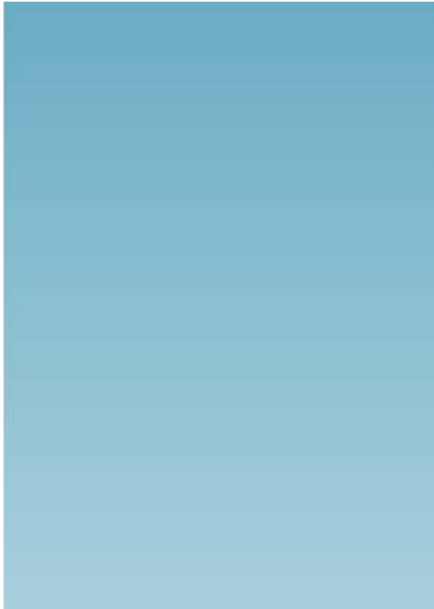
