Show a calendar to students and tell them that, in addition to sacrifices, God chose several days to be holy days.



Draw a cross on the board to refer to as you talk about paragraph one of Explore and Apply (Teacher Guide, page 69).




Ask students to share ideas before completing "Drawing Near to God", *In Class* 9 paper, page 4.



Offer a coloring page of a congregation singing or praying.

Act out student's ideas from "Drawing Near to God".



Memory Work



Use a blank sheet of paper to cover the portion of Teaching Aid 1 that you are not using.



Say the first section and have students repeat.



Stand in a circle when learning the sign for sacrifice so that students can learn from watching each other.



Using a highlighter, shorten the Bible verse on the MVP card.
