Notes for Lesson 12

1 Welcome



Demonstrate the egg illustration. Using 2 eggs, first crack one egg and add only the white. Next, crack the other egg and add the entire second egg, including the yolk (to represent the rotten egg).

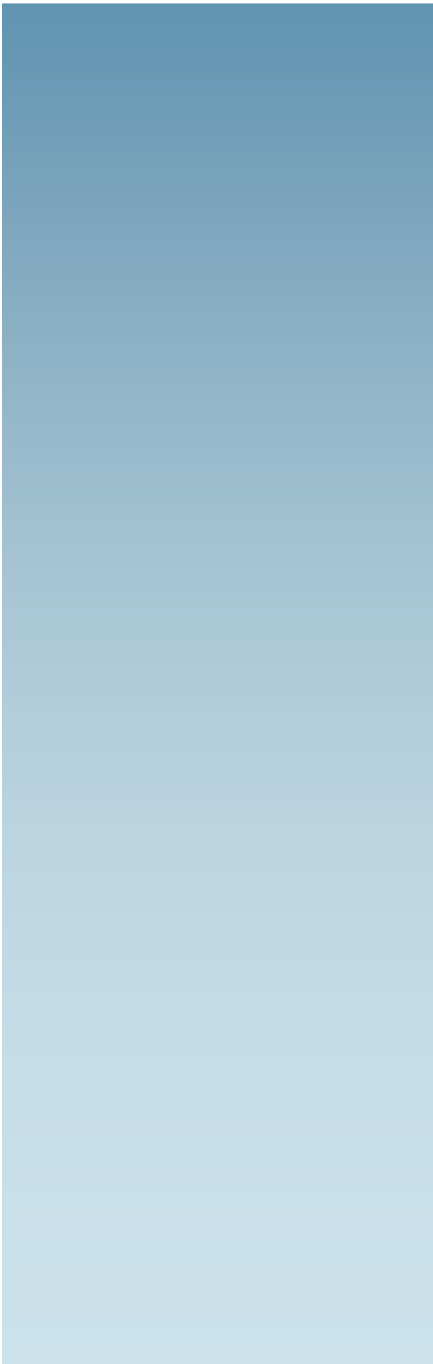
