Welcome



Attach a picture to each word card that will be used for the review game. For example, the word *Egypt* followed by a picture of Egypt.




Encourage students to work with partners. One student will draw, and one will listen for the correct answer.



Give students their own paper and pencils to draw along.



When asking review questions, offer two possible answers from which students may choose.



Bible Time

While completing "We Will Worship the Lord" *In Class 2* paper, challenge students to add hand motions to Exodus 15.



Change voice tone and volume to engage students.





Explore and Apply



Before or after students have written their answers on their papers, invite them to write one of their answers on the board.




Brainstorm for possible answers with the class or with partnered students before writing answers.



After students have written answers on their papers, ask them to pick one example to act out for their classmates.



Instead of writing, students can draw a picture to represent honor and dishonor.



Memory Work



Ask for a volunteer to stand in front of the class to demonstrate hand motions.



When you review the information on the back of the MVP card, share the story from Exodus 32 with your students instead of having them read it.



If needed, encourage buddies to offer hand over hand assistance to do hand motions.



Using a highlighter, shorten the Bible verse on the MVP card to "You shall have no other gods." Exodus 20:3a
